

## Primary Craniofacial Hyperhidrosis

Symptoms occur in particular anxiety-provoking situations and patient requires treatment only prior to specific event (i.e. work presentation, wedding, performance).

Consider p.r.n. systemic medications

Topical antiperspirant therapy (aluminum and/or zirconium salts). Pay special attention to correct application time/technique and education re. avoiding side effects.

Consider systemic meds:

1. Anticholinergics (proprantheline, oxybutynin, glycopyrronium, benztropine)
2. Benzodiazepines (short course, as needed)
3. Diltiazem
4. Clonidine
