

Common Anticholinergic Medications

- Benztropine (Cogentin)
- Biperiden
- Chlorpheniramine (Chlor-Trimeton)
- Dicyclomine (Dicycloverine)
- Dimenhydrinate (Dramamine)
- Diphenhydramine (Benadryl, Sominex, Advil PM, etc.)
- Doxylamine (Unisom)
- Glycopyrrolate (Robinul)
- Hydroxyzine (Atarax, Vistaril)
- Ipratropium (Atrovent)
- Orphenadrine
- Oxitropium (Oxivent)
- Oxybutynin (Ditropan, Driptane, Lyrinel XL)
- Tolterodine (Detrol, Detrusitol)
- Tiotropium (Spiriva)
- Trihexyphenidyl
- Scopolamine
- Solifenacin
- Tropicamide
- Bupropion (Zyban, Wellbutrin) - Ganglion blocker
- Dextromethorphan - Cough suppressant and ganglion blocker
- Doxacurium - Nondepolarizing skeletal muscular relaxant
- Hexamethonium - Ganglion blocker
- Mecamylamine - Ganglion blocker and occasional smoking cessation aid
- Tubocurarine - Nondepolarizing skeletal muscular relaxant
